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Drop Off Pick Up

Thank you so much for your support, patience and co-operation over the past three days, while we wrestle with getting all of our children safely in and out of school.

We have decided to trial new pick-up arrangements for Years 5 and 6.

If Year 5 parents arrive at the side gate for 3.20, they will be admitted into the school grounds and can collect their children from the infant yard. They can then leave through the main gate, as all other year groups will have left.

Year 6 children will leave through the side gate at 3.30pm (unless they are collecting siblings or walking home themselves via the main gate). Year 6 parents may collect them at the side gate or wait for them at the bottom of the bank. A member of staff will accompany children down to the A690.
