The Friends of St Margaret's would like to invite you to take part in our first ever virtual balloon race fundraiser.

For those who are not familiar, a virtual balloon race is a 100% eco-friendly simulation whereby everything about the race is real except the balloon, so no birds or animals are harmed during the race!

Balloons can be customised by changing various parameters (i.e. balloon helium contents; shape; thickness of rubber) and race conditions reflect real time weather conditions. Balloons can pop and go off track so design is key!

The race will run for 7 days around London landmarks. Children and parents can track their balloon's position via an individual dashboard.

Prizes will be given to the top three finishers.
