Dear Parents,

We hope you enjoyed the Easter holidays and had a relaxing time with your children. We are including, below, a brief overview of some of our work for the term ahead.

### Maths

- In Maths we will be working on; fractions, time, properties of shape, and mass and capacity. We will also continue to recap on the written methods for each of the 4 operations and be working to consolidate our 3, 4 and 8 times table facts.

### English

- In English this term, we will be reading a selection on Ancient Greek Myths and Just So Stories by Rudyard Kipling. Using these as a stimulus, we will be writing letters, diary entries, stories and setting descriptions in order to practise the writing skills we have learnt this year.

### Other Subjects

- Our Science unit this term is learning about the importance of looking after our teeth. After half term we will be learning about plants. This unit includes learning about pollination, seed formation and dispersal.
- In History we will be learning about the Ancient Greeks
- Art and Music topics will be linked to our Ancient Greek topic
- In Geography we are looking at the geographical features of cities and why the North East is so special
- In R.E the children will learning more about Hinduism
- PSHCE will cover looking at the differences between children's lives around the world
- In ICT we will be looking at branching data and coding
- In DT we will be designing and making our own pencil cases
